Ross & Baruzzini provided peer review of a design/build proposal to the Mexico City Government for a 23,000-sm, C4 operations center and eighteen satellite C2 operations centers to support a city-wide CCTV system initiative and the consolidation of multiple government entities into a single public safety facility. Scope of services included:

- Visiting Mexico City to gather data, review scope and confirm design criteria.
- Site analysis for the 20,400 sm site including vulnerability assessment, ATFP, parking garage, standoff distance, security and site access.
- Building analysis for the 5-level, C4, 23,000 sm facility which included:
 - CCTV Camera Operations Center with 118 console positions
 - Call Center with 88 call taker consoles
 - Special Operations Center with 23 console positions
 - Emergency Operations Center
 - Network Operations Center
 - Auditorium
 - Dining facility
 - Offices for multiple public safety agencies
 - Central utility plant
- Building analysis for a C2 prototype facility to be utilized as a regional satellite operations center at 18 locations around Mexico City.
- Assistance in developing verbiage for written narratives addressing ATFP, threats and vulnerabilities, redundancies and reliability issues associated with the 24/7 facility.
- Design and drawing review.
