**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE****Two Major Ross & Baruzzini Projects win the AGC 2010 Keystone Project of the Year Award**

The LEED Gold South 40 student housing redevelopment at Washington University was presented the award in the \$20 to \$60 million Building Construction project category. This new complex houses 606 students and includes large conference and lounge spaces, a retail shop, a fitness center and food service facilities for the 3,000 residents on the South 40 campus. The firm provided full mechanical, electrical, plumbing and fire protection engineering services to complete the project. Mackey Mitchell Associates was the architect.

The BJC Institute of Health at Washington University was presented the award for Building Construction projects over \$60 million. This new 700,000sf, 11-story state-of-the art biomedical research facility houses highly flexible laboratories that promote collaborative research between multiple disciplines/departments and includes BSL-3 labs and a 30,000sf vivarium with ABSL-3 lab.
